### Overview of Activities & Schedule

The members will be singing at assigned masses, with the possibility of some civic or 'out-of-parish' events. We will participate in some fun celebrations and social functions as well.

In general, rehearsals are September - May, on most Tuesdays from 4:30 - 5:45 for Children's Choir (2nd grade - 5th grade), and from 5:30 - 6:30 for Youth Chorale (6th grade and up). Parents will receive the Sept-Dec rehearsals/masses/events schedule along with this registration form.

In January each year, there will be a month-long break. Feb-May schedules will be sent out at the end of January.

### Attendance Policy

Members are asked to attend the rehearsal and mass dates as scheduled. If a member must miss a rehearsal or mass, parents are asked to email a message to [music@sfaorland.org](mailto:music@sfaorland.org), or leave a message on the EXCUSE LINE: 1-708-460-9831. If possible, we ask that this be done prior to the rehearsal or mass.

***Special Note to Youth Chorale:** Youth Chorale members are welcome and encouraged to attend Children's Choir rehearsals whenever possible.*

### Dress Policy

For masses, the choir member is Re-CHOIR-ed to wear choir shirts, dress shoes, and black pants/skirt with tights or leggings unless asked otherwise.

### Behavior Policy

Appropriate behavior during rehearsal and masses is Re-CHOIR-ed. We want to grow in number and talent. In order to be the best group we can be, every choir member is asked to...

1. Attend ALL rehearsals and masses as scheduled, and be on time!

5. Be kind to others.
6. Do not talk when a director is speaking.
7. Keep your eyes on the director(s) and watch your music only when necessary.
