The St. Francis of Assisi Community is a welcoming Christian family.

We believe in Jesus Christ and are guided by the Holy Spirit and the example of St. Francis.

We gather to celebrate, to grow in the knowledge of our faith rooted in the Catholic tradition, and to recognize our responsibility to reach out to the world.

Notes on the Scripture

The church year always ends on a downbeat: Judgment! Those aware of the three-year lectionary cycle know that three gospels are used sequentially to illustrate the idea of Christ the King, and all involve the idea of choices freely made, and judgment swiftly rendered. The first is the one we hear today: the straightforward matter of the sheep and the goats. Christ is literally described as the king who sits in judgment over his subjects. A lifetime of compassion is rewarded with compassion from the king. A lifetime of indifference and rejection? Alas, the same!

Judgment is a good way to end the church year. It's the way everything ends. At the close a satisfying day, don't we say: "Wow, that was just perfect, wasn't it?" At the finish of a difficult day, we also decree: "Glad that's over! I don't ever want to go through that again!" We judge movies we see, books we read, sporting events, leaders leaving office, our employment years at the time of retirement. And what is an obituary or an epitaph but the last word pronounced on the subject of us, the measure of our lives, the ultimate evaluation of our performance?

Judgment is how things end. It's how we end. It's how the church year comes to its conclusion. If it seems like a downbeat, we might reconsider it as a pre-assessment before the boss comes into town and evaluates each performance in real time. Each church year is a dress rehearsal for eternity. How are we doing in this pandemic year of 2020? What does that progress or regress tell us about what's needed looking forward?

Thanksgiving

Our country pauses this week to express gratitude and thanksgiving to God, the author of our lives and source of all blessing. I am truly grateful for our parish and as we make preparations I invite you to join us for our Thanksgiving Mass at 10 am. Please keep in mind that this year we have limited numbers that we can accommodate and it is important to [register](#) ahead of time. We will also livestream our mass, so that you can pray with us from the comfort of your home.

Advent Adjustments

As of November 29th, which is the First Sunday of Advent, we will no longer be able to admit walk-ins to masses. In order to insure everyone's safety, we must adhere to the attendance numbers set by the Archdiocese. Everyone must [register](#) ahead of time to attend Mass.

However, to be able to accommodate more parishioners we are adding 2 additional Masses on Sundays. Those Masses will be celebrated downstairs, in the Upton Hall at 9am and 11am. Keep in mind those will be much simpler celebrations (no music or singing) - just to give an opportunity to hear the Word and receive the Eucharist.

ADVENT IN YOUR HOME

Advent is a time of expectation and hope. “Advent” means “arrival” or “coming,” and it prompts us to pause each day in December and remember why Jesus came at Christmas. Any Advent helps us remember why we celebrate Christmas.

The word “Advent” is derived from the Latin word adventus, meaning “coming”. Most of us know Advent as a time of anticipation and expectation of the birth of Christ. Advent lasts for four Sundays leading up to Christmas. The Advent season invites us to prepare for the ‘three’ comings of Christ:

- The coming of Christ at the end of our earthly life.
- The coming of Christ at the end of the world.
- A remembering of the coming of Christ at Bethlehem.

The readings speak of these comings: **PREPARE THE WAY OF THE LORD. BE ON GUARD, YOU DO NOT KNOW THE DAY OR THE HOUR OF THE LORD’S COMING.**
