Day 1 October 10, Tuesday: Depart USA

This evening, depart Chicago's O'Hare International Airport via Air France for our overnight transatlantic flight to Paris. (D,B)
Dinner, breakfast and beverages will be served aloft.

Day 2 October 11, Wednesday: Arrive Paris | Normandy | Lisieux

Arrive at Paris CDG International Airport, go through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and a Peter's Way Tours tour manager/guide will meet us upon our exit from Customs. Board bus and soon, we will be on our way to the countryside and Normandy. Independent lunch en-route to Normandy. Afternoon, we visit the home of St. Thérèse of the Child Jesus. We will visit "Les Buisonnets", the humble dwelling of this modern-day saint until she entered the Carmel Convent at the tender age of 15. Check-in at hotel in Lisieux. (D)
Dinner and overnight at hotel in Lisieux.

Day 3 October 12, Thursday: Lisieux | Normandy Landing Beaches

Buffet breakfast at hotel. Begin our day with a visit to the Basilica of St. Thérèse, including the including the marble and mosaic covered crypt. Next we will visit the 13th Century Gothic Norman Cathedral of St. Peter. **Time will be given for prayer and reflection.** After our visit, we continue to visit the Landing Beaches. On June 6, 1944 tens of thousands of American, English, Canadian, Scots and French soldiers landed on the beaches of the Normandy coast to free France from the Nazi stronghold. Thousands of young soldiers died that first day in the name of liberty. The coast of Normandy still has the indelible scars of that event. Stop at Benouville's Bridge, better known as Pegasus Bridge. Next we'll go to Arromanches, the greatest artificial port ever created. All the armored vehicles, trucks, supplies and men came into France through this port. Take this opportunity to see the maritime vestiges that made this port so famous. Afterwards, we will go to Omaha beach, the most famous of the Normandy landing beaches. Independent lunch. This afternoon, we tour the Normandy with American's National WWII Museum. Then, in memory of the events that took place here, we will visit the American cemetery at Colleville-sur-Mer where the young soldiers were buried. **Time will be given for prayer and reflection.** (B,D)
Dinner and overnight at hotel in Lisieux.

Day 4 October 13, Friday: Full day excursion to Mt.-St.-Michel

Buffet breakfast at hotel. This morning, we leave to the country's northwestern coast. Surrounded by the sea and soaring proudly above glistening sands, the silhouette of Mont-St-Michel is one of the most enchanting sights in all of France. We will approach Mont-St-Michel by a causeway built in 1877, and enter the medieval village of 250 inhabitants by three massive stone gates. Upon arrival, visit the beautiful monastery of this tiny island. The great Benedictine Abbey Fortress that crowns this mass of granite was created in 1017. A monastery built on three levels was added to the church's north side in the early 13th century. **Celebrate Mass, followed by a recital presented by St. Francis of Assisi Church Choir at the Abbey or at the Church of St. Peter.** Independent lunch. Time will be given to explore this tiny island. Late afternoon, return to hotel. (B,D)
Dinner and overnight at hotel in Lisieux.

Day 5 October 14, Saturday: Rouen | Paris

Buffet breakfast at hotel. Today, we visit the port city of Rouen. It is located at the mouth of the Seine River on the English Channel. Rouen, packed with lovely churches and old half-timbered houses, is full of poignant reminders of Joan of Arc, who was burned alive here on May 30, 1431. A dazzling modern church and memorial dedicated to Joan, France's patron saint, can now be visited in the centuries-old market place where she was burned at the stake. Visit the Cathedral of Notre Dame in Rouen, which was often chosen by the French Impressionist painter, Monet, as the facade building in many of his paintings. The cathedral boasts a strong musical tradition since the Middle Ages. Until the French Revolution, the choir was famous for singing from memory. The first major organist was Jean Titelouze. He was named father of the French organ school, who occupied the post for the titular organist in 1588 - 1633. **Celebrate Mass, followed by a recital at Notre Dame Cathedral in Rouen, presented by St. Francis of Assisi Church Choir.** Independent lunch. Continue to Paris and the "City of Lights" for hotel check-in. (B,D)
Dinner and overnight at hotel in Paris.

Day 6 October 15, Sunday: Medieval Paris | Montmartre

Buffet breakfast at hotel. This morning, our guide will bring alive the remarkable sights of this magnificent and romantic city. We will see the Eiffel Tower, Champs

Elysées, Arc de Triomphe, Tomb of Napoleon, Place de la Concorde, the Opéra, Bastille Square and the Place des Vosges (the oldest square in Paris and one of the most beautiful squares in the world). Continue to Montmartre to visit to the fascinating Artist Square. One of the city's most well known sights is the Sacré Coeur Basilica, with its huge bell tower and onion-shaped domes. This gleaming white church rises atop Montmartre, Paris' highest hill, at 423 feet. **Attend Mass at Sacré Coeur Basilica.** Independent lunch. Afternoon at leisure. This is our opportunity to explore the sights, sounds and tastes of Paris all on our own! This is our opportunity to stroll the Jardins du Luxembourg or shopping in the famous fashion-forward Faubourg Saint-Honoree district. Independent dinner. (B)
Overnight at hotel in Paris.

Day 7 October 16, Monday: Pilgrim Churches of Paris | Concert Presentation | Cruise of the Seine River

Buffet breakfast at hotel. Begin our day with a visit to the Rue de Bac, Shrine of the Miraculous Medal. This is where our Blessed Mother appeared to St. Catherine Labouré in 1830. "O Mary Conceived without Sin, Pray for us who have recourse to Thee". Continue to visit the nearby Shrine of St. Vincent DePaul where the saintly remains are preserved and venerated. Next, we head to Ile de la Cité, where you will visit the magnificent cathedral, Notre Dame de Paris. Its massive flying buttresses, famous towers, and elegant rose windows will take your breath away. Continue to visit the nearby Sainte Chapelle, a masterpiece of flamboyant gothic architecture built by Saint Louis in the heart of the Palais de la Cité on the Ile de la Cité in Paris. Discover its unique stained glass windows rendering the air iridescent with light and color, symbols of the Heavenly Jerusalem. Independent lunch.

2:30pm - Transfer to the Church of La Madeleine.

3:00pm - Rehearsal

4:00pm - Concert presentation by St. Francis of Assisi Church Choir.

Group dinner at a restaurant in Paris, including Aperitif and glass of wine. After dinner, this evening enjoy a special cruise on the Seine River. In one single boat ride we will view historic architecture that spans a thousand years. Be on the lookout for twenty-five bridges and the many great illuminated monuments of Paris. (B,D)
Overnight at hotel in Paris.

Day 8 October 17, Tuesday: Paris | Lourdes

After breakfast, we will be transferred to Paris Orly Airport for our short flight to Pau. Late morning, arrive in Lourdes. Few visitors are prepared by what they have read or seen in pictures to grasp the sheer beauty of the place. A picture book castle and the Grotto (where the *beautiful Lady* appeared to Bernadette) is more dramatic and larger than most expect. The exchanges with the people you will meet are the most touching part of the entire experience. They seem imbued with a loving spirit that charges the atmosphere. At night, joyful singing fills the narrow streets. Laughter is woven with prayer. Pilgrims come from all nations. Whether visitors experience a healing miracle or not, most say the miracle is simply being in Lourdes. Upon arrival, we will be met by our Peter's Way tour guide. We will transfer to our hotel for check-in. **After dinner this evening, join in the candlelight procession, recitation of the Rosary and singing Hymns to the Mother of God.** (B,D)
Dinner and overnight at hotel in Lourdes.

Day 9 October 18, Wednesday: Lourdes | Sanctuaries Tour

Breakfast at our hotel. **Mass at the Grotto (To be confirmed. Liturgies at the Grotto are scheduled on the hour, 6:00 am to 7:00 pm, with the English Mass time advised two weeks prior to departure.) Please note, pending confirmation: Possible singing opportunity for 9:30am at the International Mass at the Basilica.** This morning, participate in the walking tour of Lourdes where the group will visit the places associated with the life of Bernadette. The places include the Boly Mill, where St. Bernadette was born; the Locale Mill, residence of her parents; the "Cochot," formerly used as a jail where she lived at the time of the Apparitions; the Chapel where St. Bernadette received her First Holy Communion; and the Parish church containing the Baptismal Font where she was baptized. Independent lunch. This afternoon is free for private devotions, Stations of the Cross, visiting the Grotto and Miraculous Baths. There will also be an opportunity to attend the blessing of the sick, one of the most inspiring events at the Shrine. Perhaps you will choose to return to one of the places that touched you on the tour of the Sanctuary Domain. On one side of the main square is the Chapel of Reconciliation, where there are priests available to hear Confessions. **Late afternoon, concert presentation at the Upper Basilica, presented by St. Francis of Assisi Church Choir.** After dinner at the hotel, join in the Torchlight Marian procession, praying the Rosary and singing hymns to honor the Mother of God. (B,D)
Overnight at hotel in Lourdes.

Day 10 October 19, Thursday: Lourdes | Paris | USA

After early breakfast, we will be transfer to Pau Airport for our Air France return flight to Chicago via Paris. This evening, arrive in Chicago O'Hare International Airport filled to overflowing with life-changing memories. (B)

Unexpected circumstances may cause changes to the outlined itinerary.

Acceptance of these Terms & Conditions, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: Deposits and insurance payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order or credit card. Package prices are \$100.00 higher per person when using a credit card as form of payment as the package price shown on the brochure reflects a cash discount. Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to increase package price or reduce services accordingly should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If final payment is not received by the balance deadline, Peter's Way Tours reserves the right to cancel your reservation. If for any reason payment is received within 21 days of departure, a charge for express mailing of final documents will apply. A \$50.00 late payment fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank has returned a personal check, a \$25.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check or credit card.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: From the time your deposit is received up to 130 days prior to departure, there is a \$250.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 129 to 100 days prior to departure, there is a \$350.00 nonrefundable cancellation fee per person. From 99 days prior to departure up to the day of departure, there is a nonrefundable cancellation fee of 100% of all payments made per person including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments and any other costs incurred. Travel insurance is offered as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons such as illness or injury, please see TRAVEL INSURANCE. Travel insurance payments are nonrefundable upon receipt. Tour participation is nontransferable. Names cannot be transferred on reservations or airline tickets. Refund requests can only be honored when submitted in writing to Peter's Way Tours. All refund requests are subject to cancellation restrictions as set forth above. No refund will be made for any accommodations or services included in the tour that you do not use.

LATE RESERVATIONS: A \$25.00 late fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for bookings received after the deposit deadline. All space is subject to availability and cannot be guaranteed past the deposit deadline noted on the brochure.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: All participants must have a valid passport. U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months, subsequent to return date. Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current requirements. It is solely the passenger's responsibility to ensure that all documents needed are completed and current. Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for lack of current and valid entry documents.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round trip from Chicago O'Hare International Airport on Air France. Flight itinerary and carrier are subject to changes. Departure taxes & fuel surcharges are estimated. They are determined solely by the airlines and are subject to increase prior to ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure).

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group airline reservations provide a block of seats for the group. Individual requests for seating preferences can only be made at time of check-in. Peter's Way cannot submit seating preferences as we cannot guarantee that any or all requests will be honored. If you require specific seating as a condition of your travel, it is suggested that you book your airfare individually and purchase the Land Only package. Upgrades to premium economy, business class, or first class may be available but oftentimes airlines will not allow the upgrades until time of ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure). Group reservations may not be accessible online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. Airline guidelines vary. Please contact our office for specific details.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: Land Only packages do not include any portion of the group airfare. This includes any flights booked within the group itinerary. All airline tickets will be your responsibility to book independently. A passenger choosing the Land Only portion of the package (\$2210.00) must notify Peter's Way Tours, in writing, at least 100 days prior to departure or a penalty fee will be assessed. Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package or who are deviating from the group itinerary will be responsible for their own transfers to/from hotel/airport. However, if you arrive at the same time or earlier than your group, you are welcome to join the group on the bus. It is recommended that you purchase your air transportation only after you have been notified that the group has materialized. If you purchase your own air transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel your package for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare or other arrangements booked independently.

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with changes in itineraries. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure. Deviation fee will apply plus an airline change fee per person. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference in airfare will also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact our office for detailed information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage throughout your tour at hotels is also included.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: Price per person is based on two persons sharing twin bedded rooms with private facilities in hotels throughout your tour. Double bedded rooms for married couples are subject to availability and must be requested. Triple rooms may be available for family or friends traveling together. We discourage triple room accommodations because they are usually not spacious and there is no discount for triple occupancy. Triple rooms usually are regular twin or double bedded rooms with a rollaway bed added. Single rooms are limited but may be requested at booking for an additional charge of \$595.00. While single rooms provide privacy, they are often smaller than twin bedded rooms and may be away from the group in hotels. We will make every effort (if you so desire) to match you with a same gender roommate when we receive your application, but we do not guarantee a roommate can be matched. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment or on tour), we must charge the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

MEALS: Buffet breakfast and dinner daily. Beverages (coffee, tea, mineral water) are not included at set menu dinners, please see itinerary for exceptions.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities to the tour manager/guide, and driver are not included in the package price. Although voluntary, gratuities are a supplemental income that the service industry relies on (we recommend each passenger bring \$80.00 for culturally appropriate tipping). For good work, we recommend 4,00 Euro per person per day for your tour manager; 2,00 Euro (per person per day for your bus driver; 1,50 Euro per person for a local guide when applicable. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group at the end of the tour. Other gratuities are usually handled individually. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges at the hotels are included, it is customary to leave 1,00 Euro per person for your waiter following dinner at the hotel and 1,00 Euro per person per day for the maid or housekeeper.
