As we begin 2020, I would like to review the pick-up procedures for the St. Francis Center. Many parents do not know the policies for dropping off and picking up children. This has caused problems. The policies are in place to keep everyone safe and if they are followed, dismissal only takes approximately ten minutes.

Children are not allowed to walk down the hill to their waiting car. We cannot verify who is at the bottom of the hill and it is dark. Anything could happen. We are responsible for every child until that child is in the care of their parent. Please get in the pick-up line to pick up your child or park in the parking lot and walk your child back to your car.

Please use the crosswalk at all times! Children should not be walking in-between cars. Years ago we had a fourth grader bend down to retrieve a paper, and because the driver of the car did not see him, he was almost run over. You are an adult-you should understand why we have these rules in place. The safety of your child is our number 1 concern.
